Financials	Stephanie	 Total to start the year: \$10212.72 DJ for Halloween Dance: \$510.80 Farm to Table (popcorn) \$367.78 3D Printer purchased: \$4349.43 Balance: \$4984.71 Proposed Fundraiser Goals: Valentines Day Dance: \$5000 and a second fundraiser goal of \$3000 Questions were asked last meeting about which Valentine's Dance items that made the most money: Silent auction \$2300, ticket sales \$1773.90, pizza sales \$1181. We did not currently have the expense amounts for the dance to review.
